Objections, which may only be lodged by the owner or their authorised representative must be handed to the Secretary, in writing, within 15 minutes of the incident and must be accompanied by a deposit of £20, returnable if the Objection is sustained.

1. No entry fee will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct entry fee. The organisers reserve the right to limit entries and refuse entry to an exhibitor without giving a reason.
2. The judge's decision is final.
3. Exhibitors must be appropriately dressed at all times while in the ring including the wearing of a hat, cap or headscarf. (No jeans)
4. Whips or canes must not exceed 30ins
5. The affiliated classes will be run under the rules of the Shetland Pony Stud-Book Society. Ponies entered 1-7 must be registered (foals eligible) with the S.P.S.B.S.
6. All stallions and Colts 3 years and over must be suitably bitted. Children showing colts or stallions in hand must be 14 years old or over.
7. There must be no colts or stallions in Young Handlers classes. Children under 14 yrs old may not show colts (excluding foals) or stallions in In-hand classes Hard hats must be worn by all junior handlers and all riders in all classes.
8. All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
Note. Any Pony may be measured on the day (in the event of an objection, see rules) For the purpose of this show and its classes/ resolution of complaint or at request of judge the result of measurement must be accepted on the day (unless JMB certificate produced held)
9. **For the avoidance of doubt and unless explicitly stated to the contrary, medical facilities on the show ground will be limited to standard NHS A&E callout**
