- Class 1* **Newcomers** - Ponies aged 3 years and under. This class is open to exhibitors who have been showing or breeding for less than 3 years. **SEE RULE 15.**

- Class 2* **Newcomers** - Ponies aged 4 years and over. This class is open to exhibitors who have been showing or breeding for less than 3 years. **SEE RULE 15.**

- Class 4* **Yearling Colt, Filly or Gelding** (will split if sufficient entries)
- Class 5* **2 Year Old Colt, Filly or Gelding**

- Class 7* **Gelding** (4 years and over)
- Class 8 **Mare** - 4 years and over.
- Class 9 **Stallion** - 4 years and over.
- Class 10 **Open Broken Coloured** (Piebald & Skewbald etc.)

- Class 23 **Young Handlers.** 4 to 17 years old. Mare or Gelding. **NO COLTS OR STALLIONS.** Handlers to have attained their 4th birthday before the 1st January in the current year but not have attained their 17th birthday before the 1st January. Class may be split into 10 years and under and 11 to 17 years if sufficient entries.

- Class 24 **Leading Rein.** Registered Mares or Geldings. 4 years old and over. Riders 9 years and under. Snaffle bridles only. Leading rein must be attached to the noseband on which it must remain whilst in the ring.

- Class 12* **Newcomers** - Ponies aged 3 years and under. This class is open to exhibitors who have been showing or breeding for less than 3 years. **SEE RULE 15.**

- Class 13* **Newcomers** - Ponies aged 4 years and over. This class is open to exhibitors who have been showing or breeding for less than 3 years. **SEE RULE 15.**

- Class 14* **Novice** (any age pony not having won a first prize)
- Class 15* **Yearling Colt, Filly or Gelding** (will split if sufficient entries)
- Class 16* **2 & 3 Year Old Colt, Filly or Gelding** (special rosette for highest placed 2 year old)
- Class 17* **Gelding** (4 years and over)
- Class 18 **Mare** - 4 years and over.
This class is kindly sponsored by The Champlers Stud
- Class 19 **Stallion** - 4 years and over.
- Class 20 **Open Coloured** (anything other than black)
- Class 21 **Open Black**
- Class 22 **Open Veteran** - (Miniature & Standard ponies aged 18 years and over)

* **A BEST GELDING** rosette is offered to the highest placed Gelding in classes 12 to 17.

STANDARD JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP - All 1st & 2nd placed ponies aged 3 years and under may compete in this championship.

STANDARD CHAMPIONSHIP - All 1st & 2nd placed ponies aged 4 years and over along with the Standard Junior Champion and Reserve Junior Champion are eligible to compete. The Champion and Reserve Champion will then compete with the Miniature Pony Champion and Reserve Champion for the Supreme In Hand Championship.

- Class 25 **First Ridden.** Registered Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. Any suitable bridle. Rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

- Class 26 **Open Ridden.** Registered Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Riders any age, save for Stallions, when they **must** be 12 years old or over.

- Class 27 **Driving.** Single, pair or tandem to a private driving or exercise vehicle. Show wagons and trade vehicles are not permitted.
